The First edition of the National Day of Psychological Research, event of the Italian Association of Psychology (Associazione Italiana di Psicologia - AIP), organized by the President AIP Sergio Salvatore, was held at the Royal Palace of Caserta, Caserta, Italy on May 15th and 16th 2025. The event aimed at putting the scientific knowledge of psychology at the service of society and institutions. In order to give participants, the chance to delve deeper into the issues discussed and potential interventions, the first edition's theme «The state of youth» is examined from a variety of angles, including gender stereotypes, university well-being, sustainable development, education, employment, and artificial intelligence. The event includes panels, discussions and round tables with the participation of exponents of academic and professional psychology, representatives of institutions, stakeholders, students. The event was opened both to citizens and professionals in the health, education and psychology fields, teachers and students, policy makers, representatives of the media and institutions.
